FLORECER MINISTRY UPDATE

Our first half of 2022 has gone by very quickly, We are thankful to the Lord for His companionship as we have walked besides the kids we serve on a weekly basis. We are also thankful to you for your faithful support, financial and spiritual.

We have been serving 45 children between the ages of 4 and 13 as they navigate their school work and difficulties at home. The Lord has blessed us with the opportunity to meet them in hard places and speak truth and life to their conflicted realities.

We have also been serving 2 young adults through clases for youth and adults that were unable to finish high school. These students have been hard at work at picking up where they left off, which will grant them the oportunity to get better paying jobs, and/or college studies.

On april 18, 2022, Florecer received a donation for the amount of Q30,165.27, about \$4,022 (Q7.5 to \$1.00). We detail below how these funds have been spent.

FUTURE STEPS

During the second half of this current year we plan on continuing our weekly interaction with students through our School Reinforcement program. We will also continue our interaction with our 2 young adult students that are advancing their unfinished high school education.

We are also looking for ways to continue to engage with our community, especially as we intend to spread the message of the gospel. We are planning on having discipleship training for the leadership of our home church so that Florecer's safe spaces for education expand to leadership training as well. We are partnering with CETI (Interdisciplinary Theological Studies Community for it's Spanish achronym) who are providing the resources and Andres will be guiding the training. We are starting with our church and hope to serve other churches in the area as well in the future.

During December we plan to host a Vacation Bible School for children in association with our home church, and we will also welcome children and youth from the church as well as from the overarching community.

Lastly, in January, we will host a short Youth Camp before the start of school. This activity also in association with our host church.
